<b>HB 1186</b>
To develop recommendations regarding improving outcomes for individuals exiting juvenile rehabilitation with a focus on: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Increasing community involvement before and after the individual’s exit from a juvenile rehabilitation facility;</li> <li>▪ A landscape analysis of community-based, reentry-related services available to individuals exiting a juvenile rehabilitation facility by geographic region and service type;</li> <li>▪ Community-based, reentry-related service gaps that should be addressed to ensure a successful community transition services program across the state.</li> </ul>
