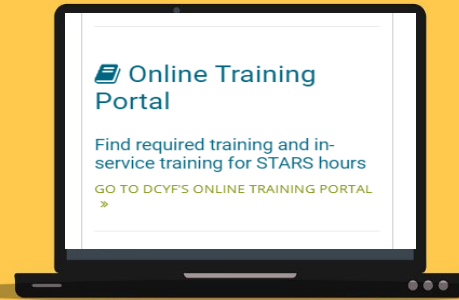

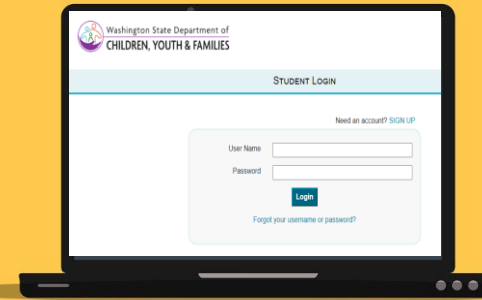

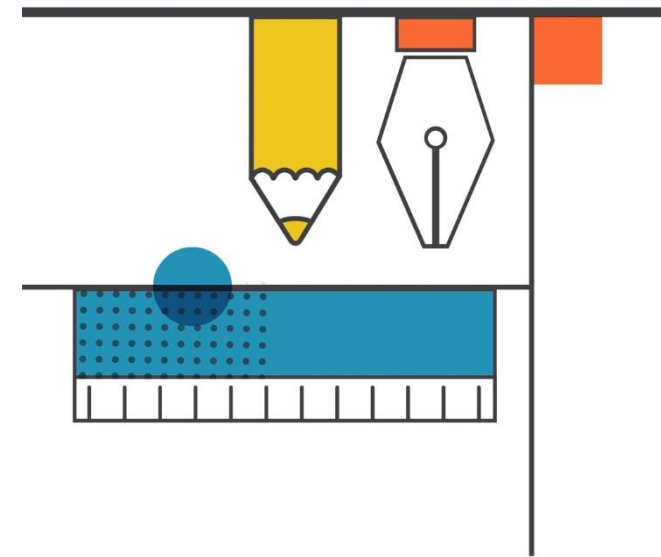


Why the New Site?
