POL 10.3.2 MANAGING CHILD CARE SAFETY PLANS

This policy applies to DCYF managing safety plans.

1. **DCYF May Issue Time Limited Safety Plans That Address A Serious Licensing Concern**
2. **A Safety Plan Must Not Be Used In Place of Enforcement Actions**
3. **A Safety Plan May Be Used Alone Or In Addition To An Inspection Report, A Facility Licensing Compliance Agreement Or An Enforcement Action**
4. **A Safety Plan Will Be Developed With The Early Learning or School-Age Provider, Licensor and Supervisor**
5. **Safety Plans Expire 30 Days After Being Signed By All Parties**

A supervisor may only approve one 30 day extension as requested.

6. **DCYF May Modify Or Remove Safety Plans At Any Time**
7. **DCYF May Take Enforcement Action When A Safety Plan Is In Place**
