In compliance with SB 6168, Section 4 (xi) (e), the Washington State Department of Children, Youth, and Families (DCYF) reports on enrollments and active caseload for the Working Connections Child Care program to the Governor, the legislative fiscal committees and the legislative-executive WorkFirst Poverty Reduction Oversight Task Force. This report is provided on an agreed-upon schedule and identifies the number of cases participating in both Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) and Working Connections Child Care programs. DCYF must also report on the number of children served through contracted slots.
