Early Childhood Education and Assistance Program (ECEAP)

ECEAP Helps Children Enter
Kindergarten Ready to Succeed.

Children may be eligible who are 3 or 4 years old and:

- Are from a family up to 36% state median income (about \$47,179 for a family of 4); or
- Are from a tribal family up to 100% state median income (about \$131,054 for a family of 4); or
- Qualify for school district special education services; or
- Are experiencing homelessness; or
- Participated in ESIT, ECLIPSE, Early Head Start, or Early ECEAP; or
- Have qualifying factors including:
 - Involvement in state or tribal welfare services
 - Chronic physical or mental health conditions
 - Other factors
