## 2 YEAR Early Achievers Grants (EAG)

### What Are My Options?

#### Supports Students Pursuing:

- An Early Childhood (ECE) Stackable Certificate
- An ECE Associate Degree

### What's Covered?

#### EAG Covers:

- Tuition and fees up to 90 credits
- Required books and supplies up to \$1,000
- Tutoring, loaned textbooks, etc.

## 4 YEAR BA Pathways Scholarships

### What Are My Options?

#### Supports Students Pursuing:

- A bachelor of arts (BA) degree in Early Childhood Education or similar approved field
- Montessori Credential at a MACTE approved academy
- Must be employed by an Early Achievers program

### What's Covered?

#### BA Pathways Covers:

- Up to \$9,000 per contract year for tuition and fees
- Required books and supplies up to \$500
