Medical, Dental, Psychology and Psychiatry Services

Accessing medical, dental and psychiatry services is easy and confidential.

There are a number of ways to get medical care:

- Nurses are available seven days per week
- A physician is on campus two to three days per week
- A psychiatrist is on campus four days per week
- Psychology Behavioral Health is on campus five days per week
- Dental services are on campus three to four days per week

You have a right to access confidential medical services and can request to speak privately to a nurse or doctor.

Daily Sick Call is between 8-9 a.m. This is when you should tell staff you are feeling sick and would like to speak with a nurse.

You can tell any staff member that you need to see a nurse, doctor, dentist or psychiatrist. You can also fill out a medical request slip, place it in a sealed envelope and ask staff to submit it to the health center. The form is confidential and asks what type of service you need.

Examples of services provided:

- Thorough intake health screening
- Physical exam within seven days of intake
- Immunizations, flu vaccine and preventative care
- STD diagnosis and treatment
- Eye exams and corrective lenses
- Psychiatric care
- Tattoo removal
- Physical therapy
- Women's healthcare, contraception and birth control
- Patient education about various topics
- Referrals to specialists such as surgeons or other medical providers
- Complete psychological testing, including, assessments, IQ, neuro-psych, certified trauma-focused CBT and exposure therapy
- Complete dental exam x-rays and cleaning
- Dental restoration care
